The North Carolina Council for the Social Studies has filed Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State of North Carolina. As a part of this process, the NCCSS has drafted new By-Laws that will provide the structure and organization for the North Carolina Council for the Social Studies, Incorporated.

The By-Laws of the North Carolina Council for the Social Studies have been modeled after the NCCSS Constitution that has been the organizing document of the Council for decades. The By-Laws preserve the structure and organization of the NCCSS and provide for the continued work of the Council as a professional organization.

The membership of the North Carolina Council for the Social Studies assembled at the 42nd Annual Social Studies Conference at the Koury Convention Center on Thursday, February 23, 2012 at 12:00 noon will be presented with a motion to adopt the NORTH CAROLINA COUNCIL FOR THE SOCIAL STUDIES BY-LAWS. A voice vote by the membership on the motion will be taken during the business meeting at the luncheon.
